## What documents should I bring?

- Valid photo identification.
- Copies of ALL W-2, 1098, 1099 Forms and the amount of other income received by you and your spouse.
- Social Security Card for you and your spouse and all other individuals you will be claiming on your return.
- Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN) for you and your spouse and any others shown on your tax return if you do not have a Social Security Number.
- Form 8332 or a copy of divorce decree if you are a non-custodial parent claiming a child.
- Account and routing transit number of your financial institution, if you would like to use direct deposit (bring a voided check for verification).
- Copy of your prior year's federal & state tax return, if available.
- Child care provider's address and tax identification number.
- 2009 paid property tax receipts or paid rent receipts.
- Correct birth dates for yourself, your spouse and your children.
