

We are privileged to lead an organization supported by so many generous and dedicated individuals and businesses committed to making a difference in our community.

Thanks to you, children are succeeding, families are stronger and older adults are living independently. Your commitment to United Way allows programs and initiatives to operate throughout Berks County to help more than 100,000 local people.

Through your continued support, you share the LIVE UNITED spirit every day in so many ways and allow us to achieve key milestones:

- By working closely with agency partners, we fund more than 50 crucial programs that touch and change lives for the better. In addition, United Way leads community initiatives like 2-1-1, which is a free information and referral service connecting Berks Countians to community resources, including child care, health programs, food banks, services for older adults and more. By calling 2-1-1 people are connected to the help they need. The service is now available 24/7 and is staffed with bilingual representatives.
- More than **1,400 volunteers** provide leadership, expertise and guidance to United Way and extend our resources to accomplish more than we ever thought possible. United Way's **Volunteer Center** links individuals and groups to community service and volunteer opportunities throughout Berks County.
- More than 350 trained **Ready.Set.READ!** volunteers work weekly with 475 elementary students to help them become better readers. This work would not be possible without the partnership with 29 elementary schools within 12 school districts.
- The volunteers and participants involved in **Blueprint for Leadership Program** are committed to cultivating diverse talent and leadership to strengthen nonprofit committees and boards.
- Generous individuals, companies and foundations provided support to the **2014 Campaign** and helped us exceed the campaign goal by raising nearly **\$9.6 million.**

- The 2014 Community Leaders Challenge Match, which provided \$200,000 in matching dollars allowed leadership giving donors to maximize their contributions. The match was generously supported by Colonial Oaks Foundation, Stevens & Lee/Griffin, The UGI Companies and one anonymous donor.

Ready.Set.READ! continues to progress as United Way and the community focus on improving early grade reading proficiency.

Third grade reading proficiency is a primary indicator of a child's academic and future success. Locally, more than a quarter of Berks County 3rd graders are not reading at a proficient level as measured by recent PSSA's. Children who do not read proficiently by the end of third grade are four times more likely to drop out of high school and 13 times more likely to drop out if they are also living in poverty.

Star Readers, the volunteer tutoring program component, has over **350 trained volunteers,** including corporate employees, college students, retired educators and community members. They volunteer at **29 elementary schools within 12 school districts:** Antietam, Brandywine Heights, Conrad Weiser, Daniel Boone, Exeter, Governor Mifflin, Hamburg, Kutztown, Muhlenberg, Oley Valley, Reading and Schuylkill Valley. The tutors work with nearly **500 first, second and third graders** needing assistance to become proficient readers, as measured by 3rd grade PSSA reading scores. Additional growth is anticipated for the 2015-16 school year.

Implementing school-readiness activities for pre-school children led to the development of the **Growing Readers program**. Growing Readers is an early literacy program developed to implement structured preschool curriculum in predominately Latino operated childcare centers. It is aligned with the Pennsylvania Department of Education 2014 Learning Standards for Early Childhood. The program focuses on providing direct support to identified childcare centers servicing **children 3-5 years of age**. The curriculum teaches and strengthens skills in preparation for entry into kindergarten.



The Ready.Set.READ! Board of Directors provides leadership and guidance to the development of this work. The governance group represents varied community sectors and consists of more than 40 individuals. Sharon Danks, Tweed-Weber, Inc. serves as the Chairperson.

Capital Area Intermediate Unit was engaged to conduct an independent evaluation of the initiative's development and implementation. The report provides confirmation of the potential for the program to have meaningful impact on improving struggling readers' proficiency and contributing to achievement of the Ready.Set.READ! 10-year goal of 90% of Berks County's third graders reading proficiently by 2023. Examples of key findings include:

- The DIBELS words-correct-per-minute (WCPM) indicator revealed that 41% of the participating second grade students moved from strategic to proficient.
- The DIBELS accuracy indicator identified that 44% of the participating second grade students moved from strategic to proficient.

Looking Ahead to the 2015 Campaign

2015 Community Leaders Challenge Match

United Way is pleased to announce the 2015 Community Leaders Challenge Match supported by The UGI Companies and two anonymous donors. This \$200,000 challenge match provides a great incentive to current leadership givers and prospective leadership givers to multiply the impact of their gift. All new and increased giving within both the Tocqueville Society and the Pacesetter Club will be matched as follows:

- New Tocqueville and Pacesetter gifts will be matched in their entirety.
- Level increases within both programs will be matched in their entirety.
- Incremental increases within both programs will be matched.
- Tocqueville Step-Up Program: Donors who commit to a pledge of \$5,000 in 2015, \$7,500 in 2016 and \$10,000 in 2017 will be welcomed into the Tocqueville Society in 2015. The challenge match will augment the gifts in 2015 and 2016 by providing the additional \$5,000 and \$2,500, respectively.
