The LIFE House accommodates children that have been removed from their home in an emergency until a foster family can be located. The children typically need a meal, a shower, clothing and a homelike atmosphere where they can be supported during this critical time.

Urgent daily needs include providing a snack or meal for children if their parent(s) does not bring food to a visit. Also, when requested by BCCYS, to provide an immediate resource to the community for formula, diapers, food or bedding (pack n play, air mattress, etc...) to avoid a child(ren) being removed from the home for lack of such resource.
