The Power of Community Change

IMPACT GRANTS POWERED BY PHILANTHROPIST MACKENZIE SCOTT

At the end of 2020 United Way of Berks County received a \$10 million gift from MacKenzie Scott. In 2021, we began distributing the dollars to support Impact Grants to expand programming and the capacity to serve our most vulnerable neighbors through the following:

Helped **Berks Latino Workforce Development Corporation** purchase and renovate **Berks Tec Centro** to provide occupational training and career services to increase and improve employment opportunities, support the local economy and strengthen the neighborhood. (\$100,000)

Expanded **MidPenn Legal's** pilot program, **Berks County Eviction Prevention Project**, to keep families in their homes. The program works in collaboration with Judge Butler's Magisterial District Court (MDJ) and landlords to stop the eviction process by developing flexible solutions and referring tenants to support services. (\$332,400)

Responded to the increased and sustained food demands created by the pandemic by supporting the addition of two on-site refrigeration/freezer units at **Helping Harvest**. The new units increase the capacity for fresh and healthier food options. Local, anonymous philanthropists matched the grant. (\$450,000)

Supported **Mary's Shelter's** renovation of transitional housing for 20 homeless youth, ages 16-22. Grant helps with the operation of **STRONG**, transitional youth housing services, which includes case management, counseling, referrals and much more for youth residents. (\$93,900)

Expanded resources for **PA 211 East** to better serve increased demands in Berks County for information and referral services. 211 is a free and confidential service that connects people to the help they need 24/7. (\$120,000)



Supported the preservation of one of the few STAR 4 high quality childcare programs available for families who work and still live at the poverty level: 90% of the **Second Street Learning Center's** enrollment. Capital improvements were required to maintain the highest rating, based on PA Office of Child Development & Early Learning standards. (\$146,161)

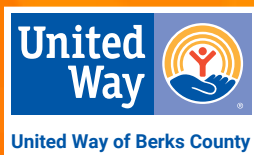
Expanded the staffing to provide care to our community's most vulnerable residents, individuals experiencing homelessness. The innovative **Street Medicine Program**, managed by Reading Hospital, focuses on improving coordination of services and preventative care for chronic health conditions for their patients at convenient locations. (\$320,694)

Princess is a member of Pendora Park Olivet Boys & Girls Club, a United Way Agency Partner. At the club, she serves as a mentor and positive role model as well as an advocate for her peers. Princess is also one of the founding members of “Girls Supporting Girls. Period.,” a project with a goal of ensuring all girls have free access to feminine hygiene products. Because of her leadership and commitment, Princess was recognized as the 2021 Olivet Youth of the Year. As the Olivet honoree, she competed with teen winners from other Boys & Girls Clubs across the state and won. She is the first Olivet Member to win this distinction since 2002.

Because of the partnership between United Way and the Olivet Boys and Girls club Berks County youth have a place to go after-school and during the summer to grow their character and become well rounded adults.

A safe environment made all the difference for Ryan. He has made many friends at Hang Time and Camp Lily, Easterseals programs. Ryan looks forward to seeing his Hang Time friends every week. It gives him time to be a typical teen hanging with his gang on Friday night. He usually sticks to what he knows and likes. His Hang Time crew encourages him to be more adventurous, like trying a spooky hayride for the first time. Even though the adventure scared him, he managed his emotions and was really proud of himself when it was over; his friends were proud of him too.

Like all teens, Ryan needs a social network to develop his identity and self-confidence. It is often difficult for children with disabilities to find a social group that is embracing and supportive. At Hang Time and Camp Lily, Ryan is surrounded by peers who accept and support him. His friends play a significant role in his development and empower him to try new things and practice his social skills.

The Power of Impact

Ready.Set.READ! Prepares Kids for School and Boosts Reading Skills



- The **Star Readers** program resumed in-person activities in 2021, and more than 150 volunteers returned to the classroom as tutors for the **Star Readers** program in the fall of 2021. The tutors were paired with first and second graders, in 8 school districts, to provide extra support to build reading skills. Everyone was excited to be back together following the pandemic pause. Efforts continue to return to pre-pandemic program numbers.

- In partnership with **Read Alliance**, first grade students at 10th & Penn Elementary School and Olivet Boys & Girls Club were paired with high school students four days a week to focus on reading. The high school students gained valuable skills through this paid work experience and the elementary students achieved measurable progress in reading skills. This program was possible through partnerships with Customers Bank and the Young Adult Program at Career Link.

- **Growing Readers** is a program focused on kindergarten readiness through high quality childcare centers. By partnering with City-based childcare centers, we are focusing on increasing the skills and retaining Early Childhood Educators (ECEs). This effort has become even more important since the pandemic as childcare was one of the industries most impacted. This program, in partnership with RACC, provides classroom instruction in preparation for ECEs to obtain their Childhood Development Associate (CDA), a nationally recognized credential. Since its inception, Growing Readers has supported 36 ECEs becoming CDA credentialed; another 15 ECEs are in the process of acquiring CDA. Plans are in place to expand efforts to work even more closely with childcare centers to increase the capacity of high-quality childcare centers and to continue supporting centers to build quality.

- One of a child's earliest classrooms is the home. That is why **Read with Me** promotes family reading by launching a book sharing program. Read with Me partners with elementary classrooms to share books on rotating basis throughout the school year. At the end of the year, students receive books to have their own library at home.

Last year, Berks residents contacted 211 nearly 14,000 times. The top requests were related to help needed for housing/utility assistance, food, and health care. The Power of Collaboration

Oakbrook Collective Impact Council is building a stronger neighborhood through resident engagement. Recent highlights include:

- Partnered with Project REACH to give residents a voice through a door-to-door survey and focus groups. The survey gathered information to identify barriers and/or their needs to be self-sufficient. The survey information as well additional input from Oakbrook residents will help shape future services for their families and children.
- Coordinated and promoted a Mobile Job Lab for residents.
- Coordinated and distributed resource packets to all Oakbrook households. (Residents identified a lack of resident awareness of available resources as a concern.)



Established an Oakbrook Community Garden to serve as a community hub and offered educational classes on nutrition.



Oakbrook residents completed ESL Training offered through the OCIC, in partnership with the literacy Council of Reading-Berks.

TOGETHER, we are the Power of Community.

We make a difference through our impactful programs:

- Graduated 13 participants from **Blueprint for Leadership** (BFL). BFL prepares participants, from underrepresented groups, for leadership roles through a 7-week program, delivered one day a week.
- **Emerging Leaders United** (ELU), our next generation of leaders (ages 21 – 45), is focused on volunteerism, philanthropy, and personal development. The ELU Cabinet, consisting of members, actively plans out their activities on an annual basis. Their calendar of activities is heavy with hands-on volunteer work while also providing exposure to local community leaders and opportunities to network with one another. Last year, ELU members held 40 activities.
- Now under United Way management, **Leadership Berks** was launched last year. The program trains and develops individuals to serve in nonprofit leadership roles through a 9-month, curriculum-based program with class members meeting one day a month. The

cornerstones of the program are placement of all participants onto local agency boards and committees and service projects completed to benefit nonprofits. The 2021-22 Leadership Berks Class completed 4 projects benefiting: Berks Alliance, GoggleWorks, Berks Connections/Pretrial Services and Rock Hollow Environmental Center. The inaugural class celebrated 20 graduates. The next class will begin in September 2022.

- United Way's **Volunteer Center** connects individuals, families, and employee teams across the county with volunteer activities year-round for community-based organizations. The Volunteer Center publishes guides for volunteering over the holidays as well as summer opportunities for youth. The Volunteer Center recruits volunteers for Day of Caring and Big Cheese, annual events sponsored by United Way. It is also responsible for recruiting and supporting volunteer tutors for Ready. Set.READ!

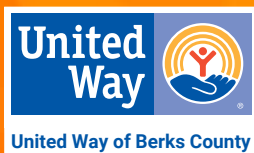

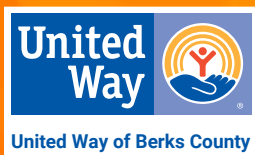
