WHAT IS LEADERSHIP BERKS (LB)?

For nearly 40 years, the mission of Leadership Berks has been to train and develop individuals to serve in nonprofit leadership roles within Berks County. In that time, more than 1,000 individuals have graduated from this highly-regarded program.

HOW DO I APPLY?

CAN I COMPLETE THE APPLICATION ON PAPER INSTEAD OF ONLINE?

Yes. Applicants may print the application, complete it by hand, and email the completed PDF to jeanmor@uwberks.org.

WHAT INFORMATION WILL I NEED TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION?

To complete the application, you should be prepared to provide:

- Basic contact and personal information, including any restrictions or accommodations needed.
- Current employer and professional background, including a **copy of your resume** (may be uploaded or sent directly to jeanmor@uwberks.org).
- Community involvement, volunteer experience, or leadership experience.
- Areas of interest related to nonprofit board or committee service.
- Your availability and commitment level for the program.
- Short written responses describing your interests and goals related to leadership and community service.
- A formal approval by your supervisor/sponsoring party (if applicable), either by having them review your digital application and typing in their name, or by reviewing and signing a physical copy.

CAN I SAVE MY PROGRESS AND RETURN LATER? HOW LONG DOES THE APPLICATION TAKE?

If completing the application online, we recommend setting aside enough time to complete it in one sitting, as you are unable to save progress and return. Most applicants can complete the application in approximately 20–30 minutes, depending on the length of written responses. If you prefer to work offline, printing the application and submitting it by email may be the best option.
