Empower Youth: Help a child keep learning and growing through a summer learning program.

Strengthen Health: Give someone struggling with depression or anxiety access to an hour of professional counseling and support.

Build Stability: Help someone returning from incarceration gain job skills and a second chance at a successful future.

Support in Crisis: Give someone escaping domestic violence a safe place to sleep when home is no longer safe.

Empower Youth: Give a girl opportunities to discover new possibilities through STEM, leadership, entrepreneurship and life-skills experiences.

Strengthen Health: Help two young children receive developmental screenings while giving their parents information to support their healthy growth.

Build Stability: Help a family stay safely in their home when an unexpected financial hardship puts rent or utilities out of reach.

Support in Crisis: Help a family strengthen its financial future through financial education and one-on-one guidance.

Empower Youth: Give two young people a year of after-school experiences that strengthen academics, healthy choices and good citizenship.

Strengthen Health: Help an older neighbor remain safe and independent at home with five essential visits from a skilled nurse.

Build Stability: Help someone strengthen their English and gain career skills that can open doors to employment in manufacturing or healthcare.

Support in Crisis: Help a young person experiencing homelessness find food, basic necessities and the support needed to move toward a more stable future.

\$1040 ANNUALLY

Empower Youth: Help a working parent access 16 weeks of quality childcare and preschool during hours when traditional care may not be available.

Strengthen Health: Help provide a year of nutritious meals for 10 homebound older adults living with medical limitations.

Build Stability: Help a family moving out of homelessness begin again with three months of support, life-skills coaching and financial guidance as they settle into a home of their own.

Support in Crisis: Help two local families put food on the table with access to a community food pantry throughout the year.
